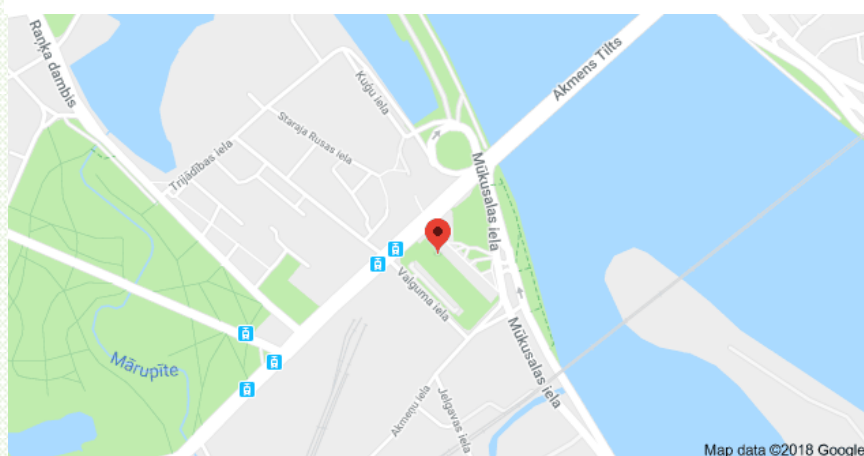
Technical details and accessibility of conference

Travel and getting around

The National Library of Latvia is located on the left bank of the Daugava, about 2 km from the center of Riga, a 20-25 minute walk across the Stone Bridge. The location of the Riga International Airport is about 10 km, 25-30 minutes by public transport, 20 minutes by taxi or private car. Accessibility in public transport is partially provided. Full accessible boarding and disembarking from public transport are only in buses and in limited number of trams. By air

Riga International Airport (RIX) is located just 10 km from the city centre and is easily accessible by public transport or taxi.

From the airport to the city

Getting to the city centre from the airport takes ~25-30 minutes by public transport or taxi. Taxi services are available at Riga airport 24 hours a day and are located outside the arrivals area. The average fare from the airport to the city centre is around € 20. The fare depends on both distance and time.

Public transport Bus No 22, Express minibus No 322 connect the airport with the city centre. The bus stop is located behind car park P1 opposite Arrival E.

Ticket price for a single journey is 1,15 *euro* bought in advance or 2 *euro* if bought from the driver. The service operates up to every 15 minutes from Mondays to Fridays and up to every 20 minutes on Saturdays and Sundays.

It can take up to 30 minutes to reach the centre. Bus and Express minibus stop near the conference venue place at the stop Nacionālā bibliotēka (National Library). Travel documents and visa applications

Visas are not required for the citizens of the EU and EEA Member States when travelling to Latvia. Citizens of these countries can travel with their national ID card or passport. Citizens from other countries may require a visa. Further details on required

The car can be placed in the parking lot of the National Library of Latvia at Mukusalas street 5. The price of the car park is 5 Euro per day.
